

COVID-19 - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ATTENDING COURT

It is very important that if you are attending a court hearing at Flax Bourton Coroner's Court that you adopt the following practices to ensure the health and safety of both yourself and the coroner's court staff.

- Please contact the court office (01275 461920) to confirm you are attending.
- Please wash your hands when you arrive at court and use the hand sanitiser provided which is located on your left when you come in the entrance.
- Maintain social distancing of at least 2 meters (6 feet) distance between yourself and others.
- Enter the courtroom by the door to your right and sit in the rows as directed by the court usher.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Maintain respiratory hygiene. This means covering your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Dispose of the used tissue immediately in the bins provided.
- Make sure you bring sufficient food and bottled water with you for your visit as we have closed our hot drinks and water machines and removed water jugs and glasses from the court rooms. You'll be able to take bottled water into the hearing room.
- Wash your hands and use the hand sanitiser when you leave the court.
- Stay informed on the latest developments about COVID-19 and follow advice given by your healthcare provider.

Most importantly:

- **Please do not attend court if you have any symptoms of COVID-19 which include fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical advice early and stay at home.**
